#### **SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES**

#### 4.1 Description of first aid measures:

Request medical assistance immediately, showing the SDS of this product.

#### By inhalation:

Remove the person affected from the area of exposure, provide with fresh air and keep at rest.
